The \$250.00 Work Party Invoice: Committee Decision

The Arlberg Ski Club committee resolved at the February 2014 committee meeting to send out the \$250 work party levy invoices within a month to those senior members who have not met the 5yr work party responsibility. A change has been made and that is for those senior members who are 65 or over as at 1 January 2014, the work party levy will not apply. This is in recognition of the many work parties our respected more senior members have completed over the many years prior.

The funds raised will go toward the maintenance activities as shared at the 2013 AGM:-Honeymoon suite room upgrade (this is being started this weekend) Repair and strengthening to the dining room floor as this is sinking and has been reported in a seismic engineering report as priority remedial work Repairs and re-painting of roof, barge boards and guttering. External wall cladding on walls facing SW and NE Repairs to deck.

As commented on in the December news letter & because of a lack of response, emails were again sent out from membership directly asking those people to complete their various member requirements,

5 Yr version said:

"This is being sent to Arlberg Ski Club senior members who have yet to meet their club obligations in regard to the 5yr work party rule introduced at the 2008 AGM; – see membership obligation at bottom of this email.
